School's Near; Motorists:
Revamp Driving Habits

LINCOLN—With the opening
of the fall school term has come
the yearly reminder from state
officials for motorists to be on
guard against tragedy.
Dr. F. B. Decker, state com-
missioner of education, says in
addition to all the children walk-
ing to class, there will be more
than 23,000 riding school buses
daily.
Nebraska law, Decker said,
clearly states that when warning
lights on a school bus are flash-
ing all traffic, coming towards
or following behind the bus,
must slow to 25 miles per hour.
When the stop arm of the
school bus is extended, he
added, all traffic must stop and
remain so until the bus resumes
motion.
The only vehicles to which the
law does not apply are those
traveling on a highway that is
divided and which are on the
side of the road approaching the
bus.
Decker urged motorists to ex-
ercise the most care to protect
the thousands of youngsters
walking to class along Nebraska
public roads and streets.
Officials noted the situation is
most critical when the schools
first open since children are still
filled with the carefree attitude
of vacation, coupled with the
thought of returning to school.
Thus, they say, the children may
forget to be careful.
"To protect these children, all
of us who drive a car or any
other motor vehicle must obey
all signs posted on the highway,
around school sites and at cross-
walks," Decker concluded.

E-H Bond Sales
'Continue Brisk'

E and H savings bonds buying
continued at a brisk pace
throughout the state last month
according to Walter H. Smith,
Plattsmouth, county savings
bonds chairman.
He reported total sales of \$6-
687,851 in Nebraska during July
for an increase of 13 per cent
above the same month of last
year. Of this amount \$70,438 was
sold in Cass County and brought
the yearly total in the county to
\$325,463 for 61.5 per cent of the
1961 "quota."
Smith pointed out that state-
wide sales have been on the in-
crease for six months in a row
with an average monthly gain of
12.6 per cent.
Sales of the two U. S. Govern-
ment securities in Nebraska
totalled \$59,123,326 for the Jan-
uary-July period equal to 61.4
per cent of the state "quota."

AN ORDINANCE CREATING
STREET IMPROVEMENT DIS-
TRICT NO. 160 IN THE CITY
OF PLATSMOUTH, NEBRASKA
PROVIDING FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF STREET
IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PLATTS-
MOUTH, NEBRASKA:
Section 1. Street Improve-
ment District No. 160 is hereby
created and shall include all of
the area within the following
outer boundaries:
Commencing at the northwest
corner of Lot 7 in Block 61 in
the City of Plattsmouth:
Thence east on the North line
of Lot 7 in Block 61 extended
to the west line of Lincoln Ave-
nue.
Thence southwesterly on the
west line of Lincoln Avenue ex-
tended to the intersection of the
south line of Lot 2 in Block 169
in the City of Plattsmouth ex-
tended.
Thence west along the south
line of Lot 2 in Block 169 to its
intersection with the east line
of Sixth Street in the City of
Plattsmouth extended;
Thence north on the east line
of Sixth Street in the City of
Plattsmouth extended to the
point of beginning.

in said District shall be im-
proved by paving, grading, curbing,
guttering and such other work
as may be incidental thereto:
