ARTICLE II  
The principal place of transacting business of the corporation shall be on the North one-half (1/2) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Ten (10) East, of the 6th P.M., County of Cass, State of Nebraska, the postal address shall be Ashland, Nebraska and the name of the resident agent of the corporation is Paul O'Brien, Murdock, Nebraska.

ARTICLE III  
The general nature of the business and the purpose for which this corporation is formed shall be:  
(a) To buy, breed, test, raise, feed, advertise, propagate, transport, sell, and deal in and with the production and breeding of swine and with services of every nature pertaining thereto.  
(b) To process, buy, sell, and distribute and deal in and with any and all other livestock foods, commodities, feeds, and mineral products of every kind and description allied with the production and breeding of swine.  
(c) To borrow and loan money, to acquire, hold, lease, disburse, pledge, encumber and mortgage real or personal property necessary for the carrying on of such business and the doing of such other business as shall be necessary, convenient or incidental thereto.  
(d) To engage in such lawful business activity within or outside the State of Nebraska.

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V  
The corporation shall have perpetual existence and shall commence doing business at the time of the filing of its Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State and with the County Clerk of Cass County, both of the State of Nebraska.

ARTICLE VI  
The affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by a board of directors, and a President, Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer, and by such other officers as may be provided by the by-laws. The board of directors shall have the power to make, alter, amend the by-laws of the corporation. The Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any regular or special meeting of the board of directors.

ARTICLE VII  
The private property of the stockholders of this corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts.  
ARTICLE VIII  
The authorized capital stock of the corporation shall consist of 5,000 shares of common stock and the par value of each share shall be \$20.00 and shall be fully paid when issued. The minimum amount of capital with which this corporation shall commence doing business shall be \$25,000.00.
