Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present: Melvin R. Todd, Harold R. Gregg and H. L. Bornemeier, Commissioners, and Chas. Land, County Clerk. Minutes of the last session approved.

Present at the hearing on the proposed county highway program were Richard Sack, Richard Spangler, Carl Ganz, Richard Cole, W. F. Nolte, Mr. Peters (Farmers National) and Robert Schichtemeier. Only Mr. Sack, Mr. Cole and Mr. Nolte questioned the proposed road program.

After some debate the Board decided to accept the program as follows:

Motion was made by Bornemeier and seconded by Gregg that the proposed road, bridge and equipment program for the next fiscal year be adopted with the following changes in roads only.

District No. 1: Change road No. 7 to read - Beginning at the NE corner Section 13 Township 12, Range 13, thence south one mile instead of east one mile.

District No. 2: Add one half mile - road No. 44 NE corner, Section 1, Township 11, Range 13, west.

District No. 3: Add one half mile - road No. 45 SW corner, Section 10, Township 11, Range 10, west.

Motion carried.

The three district foreman were present at the hearing. Clyde Thumann, Wm. A. Sneehan and Ray Hansen, to talk over the coming work for the spring with the Board and the Highway Superintendent.

The Board adjourned to reconvene on Tuesday, March 6th, 1962.
