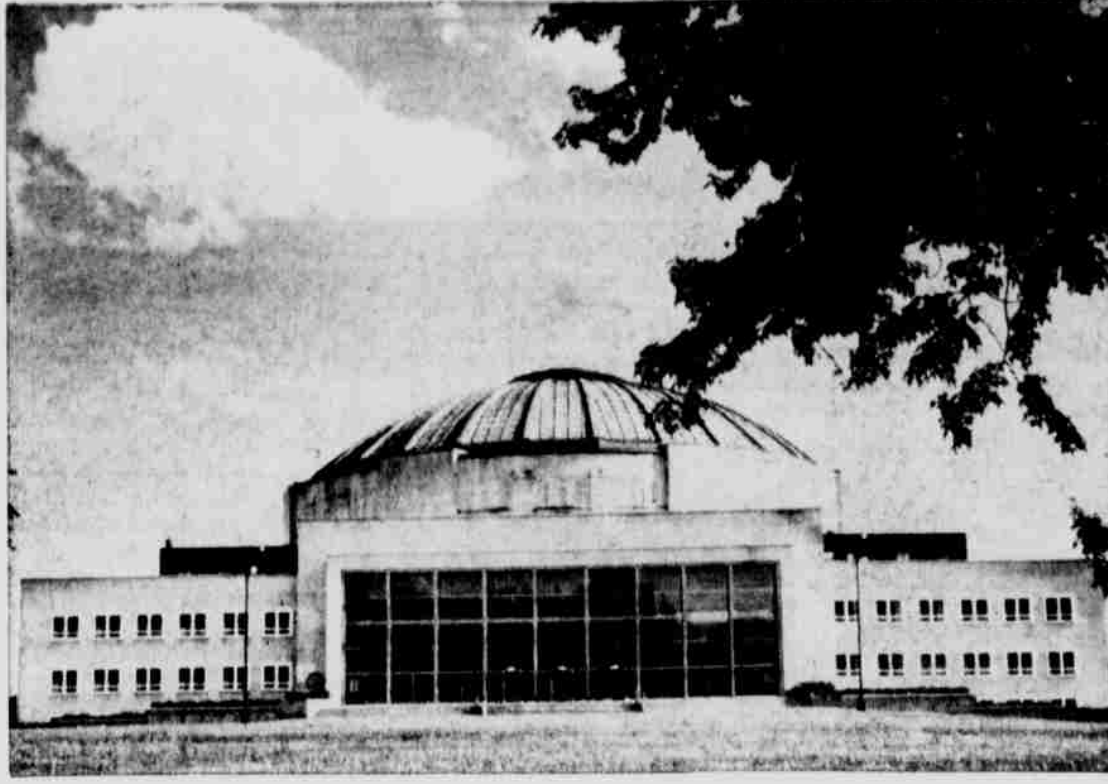
Mrs. Kennedy baked a three-tiered wedding cake.

### 'Witnesses' Set Celebration for Tuesday Night

A special public celebration has been scheduled for Tuesday, April 17, at 7:30 p.m. at the Public Library by the Plattsmouth Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses.
