## 'Backyard Farmer' Asks, Gets Answers To Timely Questions

Editors note: A new feature is initiated today, "Backyard Farmer Questions and Answers," to provide answers to lawn and garden questions being asked by homeowners across the State. University of Nebraska Extension specialists will supply the answers.

**Q. What can you do about ant hills in the lawn?**  
A. Chlordane is one of the best insecticides for controlling ants. Mix one tablespoon of 45 per cent emulsifiable concentrate in one gallon of water. The mixture should be soaked into the ant hills. One good treatment usually will clean up an ant hill—Robert E. Roselle, Extension entomologist.

**Q. What fertilizer should you use on strawberries?**  
A. Strawberries need about twice as much phosphate as nitrogen. A fertilizer such as 10-20-0 can be applied at the rate of about 6 pounds per square rod—Wayne Whitney, Extension horticulturist.

**Q. What about fertilizing fruit trees?**  
A. If you've got a fruit tree in production that is making 8 to 14 inches of growth a year, there is no need for fertilizer. Fruit trees need nitrogen unless the soil is low in phosphate. If you have one or two trees in the yard, apply fertilizer as you do on the lawn. It's best to apply fertilizer after spring growth—Wayne Whitney, Extension horticulturist.

**Q. Will bluegrass grow near a walnut tree?**  
A. Walnut trees produce a substance which is often toxic to plants growing nearby—Wayne Whitney, Extension horticulturist.

## Stronger Sheep Market Forecast

LINCOLN — The decline in sheep numbers should result in a stronger market for quality lambs, according to University of Nebraska Extension specialists.

"There should be a good market in the future for quality lambs," says E. E. Peterson, Extension farm economist.

"The expected improvement in the lamb market combined with emphasis on quality means that producers should take steps to obtain quality ewes," says Ted Doane, Extension animal husbandman. "Producers can obtain such ewes through the University of Nebraska Ewe Distribution Program."

## Homemaking 'Whys'

What will keep a waistline seam from stretching?  
ANSWER: Use a piece of woven rayon seam tape as a stay in the waistline seam to keep it from stretching.

Anna Marie Kreifels, Extension clothing specialist at the University of Nebraska, says rayon tape will work on synthetic fabrics.

However, don't use rayon tape on cotton garments. She cautions. Normal pressing with a hot iron could melt the tape. As a stay tape on cotton, use a narrow cotton twill. A tape one-quarter inch wide is satisfactory. If you have a narrow strip of the fabric selvage, use the self fabric to keep the waistline from stretching, she advises.

## 'Backyard Farmer' Asks, Gets Answers To Timely Questions

Editors note: A new feature is initiated today, "Backyard Farmer Questions and Answers," to provide answers to lawn and garden questions being asked by homeowners across the State. University of Nebraska Extension specialists will supply the answers.

**Q. What can you do about ant hills in the lawn?**  
A. Chlordane is one of the best insecticides for controlling ants. Mix one tablespoon of 45 per cent emulsifiable concentrate in one gallon of water. The mixture should be soaked into the ant hills. One good treatment usually will clean up an ant hill—Robert E. Roselle, Extension entomologist.

**Q. What fertilizer should you use on strawberries?**  
A. Strawberries need about twice as much phosphate as nitrogen. A fertilizer such as 10-20-0 can be applied at the rate of about 6 pounds per square rod—Wayne Whitney, Extension horticulturist.

**Q. What about fertilizing fruit trees?**  
A. If you've got a fruit tree in production that is making 8 to 14 inches of growth a year, there is no need for fertilizer. Fruit trees need nitrogen unless the soil is low in phosphate. If you have one or two trees in the yard, apply fertilizer as you do on the lawn. It's best to apply fertilizer after spring growth—Wayne Whitney, Extension horticulturist.

**Q. Will bluegrass grow near a walnut tree?**  
A. Walnut trees produce a substance which is often toxic to plants growing nearby—Wayne Whitney, Extension horticulturist.

## Stronger Sheep Market Forecast

LINCOLN — The decline in sheep numbers should result in a stronger market for quality lambs, according to University of Nebraska Extension specialists.

"There should be a good market in the future for quality lambs," says E. E. Peterson, Extension farm economist.

"The expected improvement in the lamb market combined with emphasis on quality means that producers should take steps to obtain quality ewes," says Ted Doane, Extension animal husbandman. "Producers can obtain such ewes through the University of Nebraska Ewe Distribution Program."
