Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present Melvin R. Todd, Harold R. Gregg and H. L. Bornemeier, Commissioners and Chas. Land, County Clerk. Minutes of the last session approved and the following business transacted in regular form. Motion was made by Gregg and seconded by Todd that due to breakdown of two trucks, that two dump trucks (chassis only) be added to the original equipment program. The Board feels that an emergency exists and instructs the Superintendent of Roads to write up the bids and specifications for same. Motion carried.

The Board instructed the Superintendent of Roads to write up the bids on new equipment advertised in the road program.

Motion was made by Bornemeier and seconded by Gregg that the Chairman sign the Tri-party agreement on Project 8066 (3) - Elmwood, east one mile. Motion carried.

The Board passed the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED BY Board of County Commissioners, of Cass County, Nebraska, that the Board of Bridges be set out and he is hereby authorized to execute for and in behalf of Cass County, a public entity established under the laws of the State of Nebraska this application, to Governor of the State of Nebraska for certain Federal financial assistance as set out in the United States, Public Law 875, 81st Congress, as amended. PUBLIC NOTICE is given that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska have passed, approved and published Ordinance No. 1028 creating Street Improvement District No. 165 which provides for the improvement of the following street in said District, to-wit:

FOURTEENTH STREET, from the north line of Highland Drive to the south line of First Avenue, also known as Pearl Street, together with all included intersections.

The said improvements shall consist of grading, paving, curbing, guttering and such other work as may be incidental thereto in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by Henningson, Durham & Richardson, Inc., Special Engineer, employed by the City, and to be approved by the City Council.

IF the owners of the record title representing more than fifty percent of the frontage of the property abutting or adjoining the street to be improved in the district shall file with the City Clerk within twenty (20) days after the first publication of this notice written objections to the creation of said district, said improvements shall not be made and the ordinance creating the said district shall be repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 1028
AN ORDINANCE CREATING
STREET IMPROVEMENT
DISTRICT NO. 165 IN THE CITY
OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA,
AND PROVIDING FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF
STREET IMPROVEMENT
THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Street Improvement District No. 165 is hereby created and shall include all of the area within the following outer boundaries: Commencing at the intersection of the South line of Pearl Street, also known as First Avenue, and the west line of Lot 3 in Block 35 in Young and Hays addition to the City of Plattsmouth.

These north along the east line of Lots 27, 28 and 29 in Hillcrest Addition to said City extended to the south line of Block 1 in Hays Addition to the City of Plattsmouth.

These north to the east line of Lot 11 in Block 1 in Hays Addition to the City of Plattsmouth; Thence north on the east line of Lot 11 in Block 1 in Hays Addition extended to the north line of Second Avenue, also known as Granite Street;

These northerly at an angle across Second Avenue also known as Granite Street to the southeast corner of Lot 6 in Block 37 in Young and Hays Addition to said City;

These north along the west line of Lot 6 in Block 37 in Young and Hays Addition extended to the South line of First Avenue, also known as Pearl Street;

These west along the south line of Pearl Street to the point of beginning; SECTION 2. The following street in said District shall be improved by paving, grading, curbing, guttering and such other work as may be incidental thereto:

FOURTEENTH STREET, from the north line of Highland Drive to the south line of First Avenue, also known as Pearl Street, together with all included intersections.

SECTION 3. Said improvements shall be made at public cost but the City will levy special assessments on the property especially benefited thereby, proportionate to benefits provided by law.

SECTION 4. All work essential for or necessarily incidental to the construction of said improvements shall be done in connection therewith as a part thereof and all of said improvements shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications to be prepared by Henningson, Durham & Richardson, Inc., Special Engineer, employed by the City, and to be approved by the City Council.
