ORDINANCE NO. 1038

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 169 IN THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Street Improvement District No. 169 is hereby created and shall include all of the area within the following outer boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the east right-of-way line of Highway 73-75 and the north line of Lot 17 in Block 1 in Richie Place Addition extended;

Thence east on the north line of Lot 17 in Block 1 in Richie Place extended to the west line of Lot 6 in Block 3 of Brown's Subdivision of Lot 17, an addition to the City of Plattsmouth;

Thence north on the west line of said Lot 6 in Block 3 in Brown's Subdivision to the north line of said Lot 6;

Thence east on the north line of Lot 6 in Block 3 in Brown's Subdivision extended to the east line of Lot 4 in said Block 3 in Brown's Subdivision;

Thence south to the north line of Lot 3 in Block 3 in said Brown's Subdivision of Lot 17;

Thence east on the north line of Lot 3 in Block 3 in Brown's Subdivision extended to the west line of Lot 24 in Block 2 in Brown's Subdivision;

Thence north to the north line of said Lot 24 in Block 2 in Brown's Subdivision;

Thence east on the north line of Lot 24 in Block 2 in Brown's Subdivision to the west line of Lot 12 in Block 5 in Duke's Addition, extended west line of Lot 10 in Block 7 in Dukes Addition of the City of Plattsmouth;

Thence north on the west line of Lot 3 in Block 7 in Dukes Addition to the north line of Avenue C, also known as Locust Street;

Thence east on the north line of Avenue C, also known as Locust Street, to the east line of Lot 3 in Block 16 in Young & Hays Addition of the City of Plattsmouth extended;

Thence south on the east line of Lot 3 in Block 16 in Young & Hays Addition extended to the south line of Lot 4 in Block 16 in Young & Hays Addition to said city;

Thence west on the south line of Lot 4 in Block 16 in Young & Hays Addition extended to the east line of Fifteenth Street also known as Duke Avenue;

Thence south on the east line of Fifteenth Street, also known as Duke Avenue to the south line of Lot 2 in Block 9 in Dukes Addition to the City of Plattsmouth;

Thence west on the south line of Lot 1 in Block 10 in Dukes Addition to the City of Plattsmouth extended west 140 feet south of and parallel to Avenue B, also known as Oak Street, to the west line of Winter Street Addition to the City of Plattsmouth which is the east right-of-way line of Highway 73-75;

Thence north on the east right-of-way line of Highway 73-75 to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. The following streets in said district shall be improved by grading, curbing, guttering, and such other work as may be incidental thereto:

FIFTEENTH STREET, also known as Duke Avenue from the north line of Avenue C also known as Locust Street to the south line of Avenue B also known as Oak Street, together with all included intersections.

AVENUE B, also known as Oak Street from the east line of Fifteenth Street, also known as Duke Avenue to the east right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 73-75.

SECTION 3. Said improvements shall be made at public cost but the City will levy special assessments on the property especially benefited thereby, proportionate to the benefits as provided by law.
