Man Here March 27**

The social security representative from Lincoln, A. J. Piccolo, will visit Plattsburgh March 27. He will be at St. John's Hall on Main Street from 9 to 1 p.m.

Piccolo, reminds Social Security beneficiaries who have total earnings in excess of \$1,200 for 1962 to file an annual report with the social security office before April 15, 1963.

If you earned less than \$1,200 last year and did not receive all your Social Security checks you must file a report to get the checks due you.

You do not have to file a report if you did not earn over \$1,200 in 1962, or you were over age 72 the entire year.
