Postmaster Dell Sherman, of Valentine, visited a couple of days with Willis Barnard.

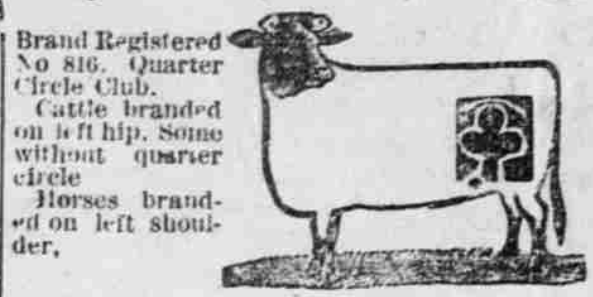
