**HEREFORD AND SHORTHORN BREEDERS TO JOIN FORCES AT SIOUX CITY.**

Probably the greatest sale of purebred cattle that has ever been held in the northwest, will be held at Sioux City, Iowa, the first week in November. It is the most prominent Hereford and Shorthorn breeders in the United States have entered into a combination to sell at public auction, 178 head of registered Hereford and Shorthorn cattle. The Shorthorn breeders will sell 70 head on Thursday, November 6th, among which are several imported animals. There are 20 head of pure Scotch cattle of highest merit. One of the breeders interested, speaking of this lot says: "No better lot will be offered for sale this season." The remainder of the Shorthorns are high-class cattle, most of them with several Scotch tops, 60 head of the Shorthorns to be sold are cows and heifers, either with calves at side, or safe in calf, and 10 bulls.

As the breeders who are selling these Hereford cattle are among the most prominent in the country and have a reputation for breeding high-class cattle, they can be trusted to send a good useful lot of cattle.
