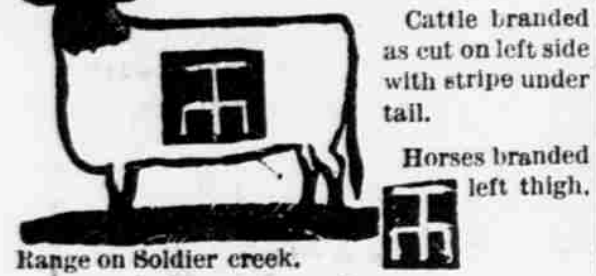

Every energy is being employed to make the occasion typical of that spirit it that has made Chicago one of the greatest cities in the world.

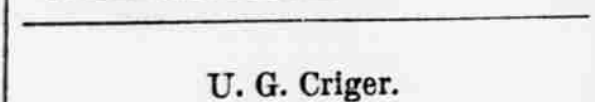
