Many merchants have complained about mail order house competition, but the operations of these houses dwindle in comparison to what a printing office is up against. The postoffice department has not only distributed circulars and cards in every post office, but also advising everyone to buy stamped envelopes, but agreeing to print a return card on lots of 500 or more. Not satisfied with this they are now sending out circulars in government envelopes on which is printed in place of the usual stamp, "penalty for private use to avoid payment of postage, \$300."

Now, mind you, here is the great government of the United States try to monopolize the envelope business of the country.

The name of every patron of the post office is furnished free, the letters are mailed free, the stamps and envelopes cost nothing and the people pay for the making of the envelopes, the printing of the circulars, etc. The only reason we can see for this extra effort to dispose of envelopes is that a company in Dayton, O., has secured the government contract and are pushing the business at the expense of the government. The people should know this and every senator and representative in congress should take action in the matter.—Publishers Auxiliary.
