We deem as especially important the forecasts of early or late frosts in which our farmers are given opportunity to protect tender plants, also the cold wave forecasts which enable stockmen to get feed together and gather in their stock from the prairies to prevent great and hazardous losses as in the early days when vast herds of cattle were swept from the Nebraska prairies and well to do ranchmen were left without stock necessary to secure their commercial paper.

Those early days were hazardous alike to stockmen and banks which loaned money on stock. The thrift and heart of the stock business on the western prairies owe much to the local Weather Bureau and its timely warnings which enable many ranchmen through the telephone system to spread the news from Valentine of the approach of a storm which


