What Will Happen During 1910.

One of the most natural instincts of the human race is to endeavor to pry into the future. It has always been so, and we presume, will always be so as long as humans are humans.

Recognizing this weakness, the papers at the first of the year are full of astrological prophecies with reference as to what will occur during the year 1910. Although these prophecies have been made seers in various lands, they exhibit a remarkable unanimity so far as those happenings presaged to various countries are concerned. The following, from the World Herald is along the same general lines as the others, with the addition of being much more terse, while covering the same ground:

During the winter quarter, which lasts until March 20, there will be many configurations of planets that are held to be greatly powerful for disturbances. They point to fire, angry passions among the people and contentions between nations. There is danger of class disputes and riotous outbreaks in many lands. Crimes and scandals will be rife.

Over Washington, D. C., the sun's ingress took place in what astrologers call the first house, with Mars and Saturn in the fourth house, and Mercury ruling the seventh house. These signs indicate astrologically that there is a strong probability of great storms along the Atlantic coast. The signs of the spring quarter of 1910 point to great advance in the knowledge of the hereafter and in physic science, shaking many of our accepted scientific beliefs about mind and matter.

Floods of appalling magnitude are threatened, and great efforts will be needed to avert them.

The orient is threatened with war and rebellion.




