The Valentine junior normal will begin June 6, 1910. The first week will be Cherry county institute. All Cherry county teachers are expected to attend.

I have the names of ladies who will furnish both board and room to the teachers for \$3.75 per week. I have the names of some who will rent rooms furnished for light house keeping. It will be well for those who expect to find boarding places through this office to write as soon as possible.

We will arrange for the enrollment June 4 and all are requested to enroll not later than June 6.

Tuition and use of necessary text books are free, but an enrollment fee of \$2.00 will be charged, which will entitle the student to all the privileges of the junior normal, county institute, and the lecture and entertainment course. Those who enroll for institute only will be charged only the regular institute fee of \$1.00.

The first number of the entertainment course will be an illustrated lecture by Mr. Abbott of Lincoln, Thursday evening, June 9th.

The faculty has been selected from among the strongest educators of the state, and provision has been made for special instruction in all the important lines of the teachers' work.

Anyone who wishes to take advantage of this opportunity to better prepare themselves especially for the work of teaching is cordially invited to attend.

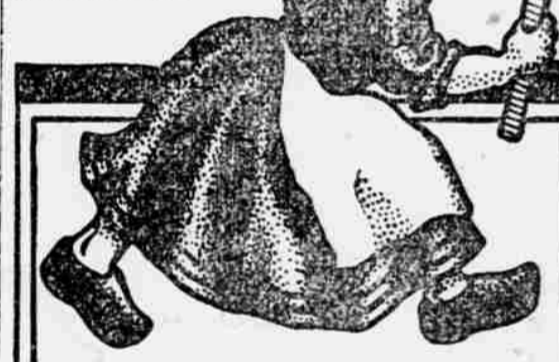
