



Juarez, Mex., May 24.- A telegram was received by Francisco Madero, Jr., from Alfred Robles Dominguez, special neace envoy in Mexico City, stating that the resignation of Vice President Corral had been tendered. The news was taken to mean that the vice president's resignation was requested to precede that of President Diaz, which is expected today.
