St. Edwards Man's Death.

Omaha, Oct. 15.-Unexplainable features in the death of William Vizzard of St. Edwards, Neb., developed at the inquest Wednesday morning. A verdict finding that the man met his death from a hemorrhage on the Tenth street viaduct Monday night was returned. The body will be sent to St. Edwards, where the funeral will be held Friday.

Vizzard was 61 years old. He was a retired blacksmith of St. Edwards and owned several fast horses and was never known to be without money, usually in large quantities. His brother, J. C. Vizzard, the special agent of the Union Pacific railroad, well known in Omaha, says that he cannot understand the finding of his brother with but a few cents in his pocket.

"There is something peculiar about this matter," said J. C. Vizzard Wednesday morning, "for this is the first time I ever heard of William being without money. An investigation will certainly be made."
