Mr. Early has offered money to compromise several times, which at least shows that he knows he is in the wrong, besides the courts of Nebraska have decided that a forfeiture can only be declared by legal proceedings. The land commissioner has also stated that Mr. Early has no legal right to the land, and I think it unfair for a public officer to act so concerning my deceased father's property.
