CITY ELECTION.

A Little Mixed But a High-License Victory.

We present, in tabular form this morning, a full report of the election yesterday. Everything passed off quietly. The republicans are well pleased with the action of their convention and made a good canvass for the short time that their opponents, the democracy, were in the field, that ticket having been nominated about 10 p. m. the evening before election.

Let the same spirit that made itself manifest in the adoption of their platform—a strict enforcement of the laws and ordinances—be made manifest throughout the next year, as occasion presents, and the contest of yesterday will not be without very substantial beneficial results, in the government of the city.

There was no contest between the two parties for members of the school board, republicans nominating Kramer and democrats Davis.

Mr. Whitmoyer, who was, during his absence, and without his consent or knowledge, placed upon the democratic ticket for councilman of the Third ward, is a republican, and had emphatically said to friends who wished to nominate him on the republican ticket, that he

would not serve if elected, even by a unanimous vote. He had served long enough, he said.

Mr. Gluck, who was defeated at a prior election because he favored an occupation tax on saloons, was elected councilman for the Second ward on that issue.
