# a Little Mixed But a High－License Vic－ tory． 

We present，in tabular form this morn－ ing，a full report of the election yester－ day．Everything passed off quietly． The republicans are well pleased with the action of their convention and made a good canvass for the short time that their opponents，the democracy，were in the field，that ticket having been nomi－ nated about $10 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$ ．the evening before election．
Let the same spirit that made itself manifest in the adoption of their plat－ form－a strict enforcement of the laws and ordinances－be made manifest throughont the next year，as occasion presents，and the contest of yesterday will not be withont very substantial beneficial results，in the government of the city．
There was no contest between the two parties for members of the school board， republicans nominating Kramer and democrats Davis．
Mr．Whitmoyer，who was，during his absence，and without his consent or knowledge，placed upon the democratic ticket for councilman of the Third ward， is a republican，and had emphatically said to friends who wished to nominate him on the republican ticket，that he
would not serve if elected，even by a unanimous vote．He had served long enongh，he said．
Mr．Glnck，who was defeated at a prior election because he favored an oc－ cupation tax on saloons，was elected conncilman for the Second ward on that issue．
