

The Week in The Legislature.

When the senate convened on the 17th the standing committees reported favorably a number of bills for passage. S. F. 223, relating to the same law as was passed. It makes it unlawful to kill quail at any season of the year, on the ground that they are nearer a domestic bird than all other species of quail.

The senate on the 23d postponed H. R. 137, better known as the Pollard revenue bill. The bill did not appear to have a strong champion in the senate at this late day in the session, although four members opposed its postponement without some consideration.

The whole to consider bills on sitting bill No. 137, which provides that police judges and city attorneys shall be elected by the people instead of being appointed by the mayor, as is now the case.
