

### WHAT SORT OF FRIEND?

With a pension roll containing nearly 1,000,000 names—the largest number it has ever held—the clamor for the removal of Commissioner Evans because he is not a “friend of the soldier” seems to be somewhat ludicrous. The Civil War ended thirty-six years ago, yet during the year just closed, 44,225 new pensioners were added to the rolls and 3,657 names were restored to them, while the losses from deaths and other causes were 43,586. The total number of names on the rolls now is 997,735, and the disbursements during the year aggregated more than \$138,500,000. More than 45,710 applications for pensions growing out of alleged disabilities incurred in the war with Spain, or twenty per cent of the total number of men engaged, have been filed, against only six per cent of the Union army filed during the first seven years after the close of the Civil War. Surely no country on earth has been more generous to its war veterans than ours has been, and in no country could there be less ground for clamor for more “liberal treatment.” Secretary Hitchcock speaks in high commendation of Commissioner Evans in reporting the condition of the Pension Bureau to congress, saying that the

army veteran has no more sincere friend, and yet, from the moment of President Roosevelt's entry upon office, the Grand Army men have been besieging him for the removal of Mr. Evans. What is their idea of a friend?—New York Commercial Advertiser.
