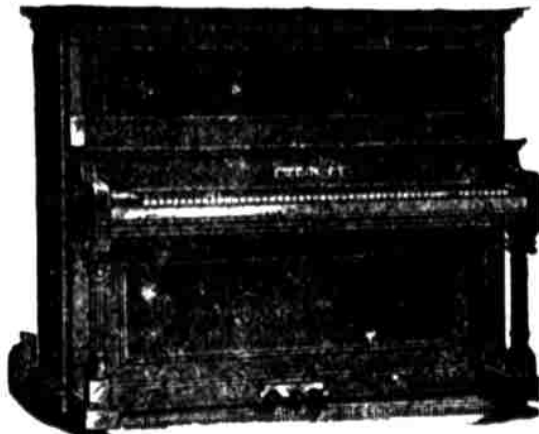

#### IN OTHER COLLEGES

The faculty of Knox college voted to make Washington's birthday a permanent holiday at that institution.

The Minnesota Daily has bestowed the complimentary name of "Flickertails" upon the North Dakota basketball team.

The Baptists of the middle west will raise \$100,000 for the construction of a new Divinity hall at the University of Chicago.

Six men have been chosen in the preliminaries at South Dakota to represent that university in the intercollegiate debates.

New card cases for the library have been suggested as the memorial presented to the University of Illinois by the present senior class.

Books have been turning up at second-hand book stores in Minneapolis too frequently to suit the students of Minnesota and some startling revelations have been forthcoming as a result.

The chess contest now going on between the University of South Dakota and the University of Iowa promises to be an interesting one. Eight moves have been made by each side up to the present time. The games are pretty even so far, as might be expected at this stage, but some interesting problems must be forthcoming shortly.

The students of the University of California put into perfection this week a grand scheme for making pathways on the campus, and saved the university a sum of fifteen hundred dollars. A thousand students worked for eight hours and at the end of that time 2,350 feet of pathway had been constructed. The co-eds furnished lunch at noon and one of the storekeepers of the town sent down a barrel of lemonade to enliven matters. In the evening a celebration was held at the Greek theater and a large amount of fireworks disposed of and many speeches made.

12. Should cities of over forty thousand population adopt a system of municipal government concentrating executive and administrative power in the hands of the mayor?
