MADE A HIT.

"Everyman" Took Well on Presentation at Vassar.

The following clipping from Vassar College "Miscellany," will be of interest on account of the presentation of "Everyman" under the auspices of the Dramatic club next Thursday. "The college owes its unbounded gratitude to the 'unknown friend' through whose generosity it was possible for us to see the fifteenth century morality play, Everyman. The performance was given in the college chapel on the evening of December 3, 1903, by the Elizabethan Stage Society of London. This society is made up

of men and women of unusual scholarly and artistic appreciation, who present from time to time early English plays rarely acted by theatrical companies.

"The play was interesting and delightful for its literary value and for the artistic way in which it was presented. A successful effort was made throughout, in the staging and in the acting of the play, to give the spectators just such an impression as the moralities made upon the fifteenth century audience. The chapel was a singularly good place for the performance, being easily transformed, with the help of the simple scenic background, to the original scene of the morality plays, which was generally the porch of a church. The costuming was historically faithful to fifteenth century models, and the tableau effects were strikingly picturesque."
