M. H. Swenk, assistant in the department of entomology, made a trip to Fairfield Tuesday in the interest of the work of the state entomology.

Professor Brunet, of the department of entomology, addressed the meeting of the Nebraska entomological society, held in the Entomology laboratory last evening.

The excavating work on the ground for the Administration building is about completed and it is expected that the work of the construction of the building will be pushed from now on.

Professor Bessey is preparing a review of De Vries' book on the mutation of species and varieties for publication in one of the New York journals. It will appear within a few weeks.

Several of the forestry boys have already secured positions for the summer in the U. S. Forest Service, and a number more are taking out papers for civil service examinations to be held soon.

Professor Heald of the department of botany is investigating a disease of the pine seedlings which were sent to the department from the U. S. forest reserve at Halsey, Neb. He hopes to be able to suggest a remedy.

Messrs. G. A. Barrett and E. E. Blackman recently visited a mound near Ruby, Nebr., which was supposed to have been a burial place of the early Indian tribes of the state. After a careful investigation they found it to be natural and very interesting from a geological standpoint, but nothing was found to indicate that the Indians had ever had anything to do with the building of it.
