

This observatory was built by a wealthy Greek and ionated to the state. There is also to be found there a women's college, in which upwards of 1,600 girls receive

Conspicuous among the statues of Plato and Socrates and other noted nen of Greece is the statue erected in nemory of Gladstone. Mr. Gladstone was instrumental in prevailing upon he English house of commons to make o Greece a present of the Ionian Islands, which perhaps accounts for the reverence of him by the Greek peo-
