There are seven vacancles on the Board at the present time and all are expected to be filled within a few days. Two of these members will be chosen from the Faculty, four from the student body, and one from among the citizens of Lincoln.

Misses Leah Meyer and Mildred M. Slater, who were student members of the Board last year, have both left Lincoln and are teaching in the state.

The Administration Building.

The Administration Building, the latest building to be added to the University's equipment, is also one of the finest. It was recently completed at a total cost of about \$35,000. Of this sum approximately \$3,000 was spent on equipment. It is of the classic style of architecture, made of dull sand-finished brick, trimmed with terra-cotta. The architect was Thos. R. Kimball, of Omaha, and the contractors, Stephens Bros., of this city. All equipment was installed under the supervision of Mr. Chowins, the University Superintendent of Construc-

The halls of the building are finished in oak, making a pleasing contrast with the white walls. All desks and similar equipment in the offices are also of oak, but the room finishings are of hard pine. Stairways and doors are of oak.

The Chancellor's offices in Room 101 are very tastefully furnished. In the private office are handsome desks, elegant rugs, and a beautiful terracotta fireplace, which is useful as well as ornamental. At one side is a rest room, well furnished.

The Chancellor, in common with all the other officials, expressed himself as more than pleased with his new quarters.

The Treasurer's and Registrar's departments, in Rooms 102 and 103, are well equipped for their respective needs. Each officer has his private office and vault.

Little can be said of the remaining offices that has not been said of the other rooms. All are well equipped and tastefully furnished. It may be said that all, both students and occupants, are more than satisfied with their new building. Especially is this true of the forces of the "Rag" and "Cornhusker," who have been seriously cramped hitherto.
