AN APPEAL FROM RUSSIA.

Dr. Wolcott Receives Request for Aid from University at Moscow.

Dr. R. H. Wolcott, Professor of Anatomy, has received the following letter from the department of Ichthyology, i. e., that branch of zoology pertaining to fishes, of the University of Moscow:

"Dear Sir: On the 13th of December, 1905, during the insurrection, the building of the Moscow Aquarium was destroyed by fire. Among other valuable things, it contained a library of the Section Ichthyologique, which it had taken 27 years to collect and that under trying difficulties.

Earnestly desiring to renew our scientific pursuits and possessing no means with which to re-establish the library, we are compelled to trust to the sympathies of authors, hoping that with their aid it will be possible to collect a new library, which, though small, may yet enable both the Section and the oldest Biological Station in Russia, connected with it, (situated on the Lake Gloubokoje, government of Moscow) to continue their pursuits.

Accordingly, the Section makes free kindly to beg you, Dear Sir, to contribute to the library whichever work of yours you may see fit to make a donation of.

This letter throws an interesting sidelight on current history in Russia, showing the terrors of the rebellion there, and also the enormous difficulties with which the Russian champions of the cause of education have to contend. It is a credit to the University of Nebraska to have in its faculty men whose work is known even in benighted Russia. Dr. Wolcott intends to send a collection of books in answer to the request. Dr. Ward has already sent a large number of books, and several other members of the faculty are thinking of doing the same.
