Dairy work begins today under the instruction of Mr. Haecker.

Mr. Deemer, of the firm of Magee & Deemer, visited the Farm yesterday on business.

Last year the total registration was 350, divided as follows: Long course, 170; short course, 180.

Dr. Lyon will have charge of this year's work in farm experiments. The work will be conducted by the graduate students.

Registration up to the present time is 157, which is a gain of 33 per cent over the registration for the same period last year.
