"Bill" got the ball on the 50 yard line and returned 10 yards. A 15 yard penalty forced Weller to punt and Angney returned the ball almost immediately. Nebraska was penalized another 15 yards and Weller punted to the center of the field.

The ball changed hands frequently, nothing startling happened until Wallace tried a place kick from the 35 yard line, which fell short, however, by 10 yards. Cooke returned to the 28 yard line and Nebraska was penalized again for 15 yards. Weller punted to Angney, who signaled for a fair catch on the 48 yard line. Again Wallace tried a place kick, but failed.

Nebraska kicked out and advanced the ball steadily to Kansas's 15 yard line, when a forward pass from Cooke to Johnson gave Kansas the ball. Kansas punted out of danger and Nebraska advanced the ball again by means of a 40 yard run by Cooke. Kansas was penalized 25 yards and Coach Foster sent McDonald in to take "Bill" Johnson's place at end. Gil tried a drop kick, but the line could not hold and the ball was blocked.
