one or two college classes have requested the faculty to leave the students entirely to their own devices during examination periods, a responsible committee being elected by the students which would report to the faculty in case the plan was not successful. The committee is of the opinion that last spring's examinations of the Academic Junior class, which were conducted in this way, were satisfactory from every standpoint. I think that this movement is apt to spread. My one great conviction, however, on this matter is that we should emphasize the honor spirit rather than the honor system. If student public opinion can be united in favor of a few planks in a platform which will give the ideals of a Christian gentleman, it will not take very long for the student body as a whole to rise to these ideals.
