HIGHER SALARIES.

from which we take the following statements:
University of Minnesota for the year ending June 30, 1906, salaries and wages \$476,737.26
University of Michigan (not including agricultural college) 445,757.00
University of Wisconsin (year ending June 30, 1904) 323,527.00
University of Iowa and the Agricultural College 396,483.02
University of Nebraska, including Agricultural College 213,312.00

"It will be observed that the annual expenditures for salaries in Michigan and Minnesota are more than the biennial expenditures of Nebraska, and in Iowa are nearly twice as much annually.

"To illustrate the difference in salary account a comparison by departments is useful. Taking two leading departments, German and Political Economy:

In the University of Wisconsin the salary account is
—Department of German \$14,332.00
Political Economy 14,450.00
In Nebraska the salary account in the German department is 5,200.00
Political Economy 6,400.00

"The lower cost of Nebraska is due to the fact that it employs fewer men in proportion to the students in attendance, and pays much lower salaries. The maximum salaries for deans and professors in these states are as follows:

Wisconsin	4,500	3,500
Nebraska	2,500	2,200

"This schedule explains why Missouri, Wisconsin and Iowa have taken several of our strongest men."
