Tickets for Shakespeare's "Taming of the Shrew," which is to be given Theater matinee and evening performTheater matinee and evening performon sale to University students Saturday afternoon, May 25, in Memorial Hall.
The sale will begin at 1 o'clock when seats may be purchased by Senlors who have paid their class dues by that time.
