

HON GEO. F. WILLIAMS.

At Convocation Tells of Proper Way to Live.

Hon. George F. Williams of Boston spoke at Convocation yesterday upon experiences which cannot be gained thru reading nor thru speech. All his suggestions were personal and intended to ald us as students. Our success, Mr. Williams said, depends very largely upon what we inherit from our parents. Father and mother are the most important influence in a man or woman's life. Strong constitution and good health cause differences in human nature, and we are not responsible for these advantages or disadvantages of heredity. We should bestow mercy upon our less fortunate fellows and be charitable in our judgments. Many studying men do not understand the duty they owe to country, nor how little they give in return for the products and blessings of labor, sacrifice, bloodshed and martyrdom. In his own life he spoke of the law book he published and how two years afterward he was recommended for the editoriship of an annual book because of his care and accuracy displayed. Any thoro work, even the done for the merest pittance, is always worth while. What we do and think is largely a matter of habit, and strength of life consists in forming good habits so that methods may become involuntary. As soon as a man thinks he knows it all, at that moment his usefulness and development cease.

Borrowing trouble is largely a habit and sixty per cent of our energy is spent in worry. What is a typical old maid but a wry faced, sour individual, fretting and worrying over trifles.
