### AN INCREASE.

College of Medicine Has Large Enrollment.

The college of medicine at the University is one of the departments in the school that has shown a decided increase in attendance over last year. The registration in this department began at the same time as the enrollment in the other courses but many advanced students came in late and not until the present time has the status of the attendance been known. A part of the increase in enrollment may be due to the fact that this fall is the last opportunity which students will have to secure at the university the old four year course. On January 1, 1908, the entrance requirements become one year of college work above the high school course. It is not necessary, however, that this preparatory year must be spent at this university, but it must be in some institution of collegiate rank, where the prospective student must take work in chemistry, German and animal biology.
