The refusal of Father Buell to grant the Georgetown university students a holiday in honor of St. Patrick's day, was the occasion for a general student riot. After smashing crockery and other things and nearly drowning one of the Jesuit fathers with a stream from a fire hose, the students marched from the university grounds in a body. Twentyfive were expelled on their return from the city and one hundred and thirty have been suspended.

The supreme court of Missouri declared unconstitutional a new law prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquor within five miles of any state educational institution having 1,500 students enrolled. The law applied only to the Missouri State University at Columbia.

The architect's plans for the Memorial gymnasium to be built at Purdue have been accepted by the building committee. It is to be a memorial to the students who were killed in the fatal wreck of 1903.
