

The Harvard Medical School

With the completion of the new buildings, which were dedicated Sep-tember 25th, 1906, this school now has facilities and equipment for teach-ing and research in the various branches of medicine probably unequaled in this country. Of the five buildings, four are devoted entirely to lab-oratory teaching and research. Numerous hospitals afford abundant op-portunities for clinical instruction in medicine and surgery.

COURSE FOR THE DEGREE OF M. D.

A four years' course, open to bachelors of arts, literature, philosophy or science, and to persons of equivalent standing, leads to the degree of M. D. The studies of the fourth year are wholly elective; they include laboratory subjects, general medicine, general surgery and the special clinical branches.
