## IS WANTED AT PERU

NEBRASKA PROFESSOR RECEIVES FLATTERING OFFERS.

## TO EXTERMINATE LOCUST PEST

NOTED ENTOMOLOGIST WANTED BY ARGENTINA ALBO.

Professor Bruner, Who Receives Two Requests From South America, Has Worked in That Part of the World Before.

Professor Bruner, of the entomology department has received a very flattering offer to go to Peru, South America. The offer was received a short time ago, through the Peruvian consulate at New York City. The offer is an effort on the part of the Peruvian government to get Professor Bruner to go to South America and attempt the work of ridding the nation of Peru, of the greatest pest it has, the locust. For a number of years this country has been devastated by this pest, but for the past two or three years the insect has not made its appearance in that part of South America. Recently the locust has again appeared in Peru and commenced its work of destruction, and the government has decided to resort to every means possible to rid the nation of this pest, and at least to stop the ravages of the insect in the infested district. This district being nearly one thousand miles long, the enormous proposition before the one who undertakes this work is very great.

### Not First Mission.

The request for Professor Bruner coming as it does from a nation, in the time of so great a need, reflects credit upon the work being done in this institution. It also recognizes Professor Bruner as being one of the best authorities in this branch of entomology. This is not the first mission of this kind which Professor Bruner has been requested to undertake. Eleven years ago he returned from the Argentine republic after coping successfully with a similar pest.

The professor has just received another letter from this government requesting him to take up the work of locust extermination there. Thus at the present time his services are requested at both the Peruvian and Argentine republics.

### Professor Bruner Undecided.

Professor Bruner is at present undecided as to what course to pursue in taking action on the matter. He has replied to the Peruvian government and is awaiting further action in regard to the acceptance of his terms. To accomplish the enormous work required it would necessitate a leave of absence from his work in the university for an indefinite length of time. The position, besides being of exceedingly great importance in the entomological sense, carries with it a large financial compensation.
