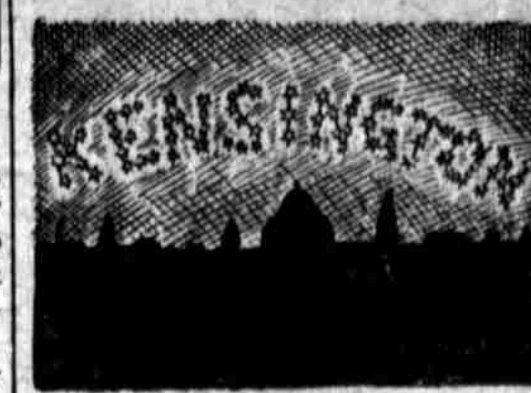
A freshman class rally will be held in Memorial hall Friday from 12:30 to 1 p. m. Everybody out.
