earth one yard from the goal line. Rathbone went through the line for the touchdown on the next play. O. Frank kicked goal.  
 The first quarter of the second half snuffed out all hope Ames ever had of carrying off the game. Twice the Cornhuskers carried the ball across the field with a steady march that Ames could not check, and twice Fullback Rathbone plunged the line for touchdowns. Twice, also, O. Frank sent the ball spinning over the bar.  
 The fourth touchdown was made during the last few moments of the last quarter. Ames had carried the ball to Nebraska's ten-yard line, where they found themselves against a veritable stone wall and had to surrender the ball on downs. O. Frank punted to the center of the field. Ames failed to gain and Smith punted. Frank again punted and Lofgren fell on the ball when Hurst fumbled the catch. Ames was penalized five yards on an off side play. Owen Frank went around for ten yards. Shonka contributed five, and Temple carried the ball to Ames' two-yard line. For the fourth time in the game Rathbone went through the line for the necessary distance. O. Frank again kicked goal.
