## OPEN SEASON FOR STARS

ALL-CLASS TEAM IS SELECTED FOR DAILY NEBRASKAN.

### MIGHT GIVE VARSITY HARD WORK

INELIGIBILITY OF MEN MAKES SELECTION DIFFICULT.

Class Football Players Show Up Well and Would Make Strong Combination.

Now that the season for picking teams for the All-So-and-So team is on, and that the entanglements of the class games have been cleared away, it is only natural that an All-Class team should be picked. In many respects this is a rather difficult task, in as much as two of the teams participated in only one contest and also due to the fact that over half of the men on one team and three on another were ineligible. In picking the All-Class team the men who were ineligible were not considered. This in itself has kept many players off of the team who would have otherwise have made it with ease.

#### Dobbs as Center.

The position of center is given to Dobbs. Although not fast, he is heady, aggressive and shifty. This combined with his experience, having already played on three championship class teams, gives him the position ahead of the rest of the centers. Curtis of the juniors also deserves mention.

The material for guards is not near as strong as that for other positions, none of the teams having exceptionally strong guards. In order to get the strongest combination it was necessary to shift George from a tackle position to that of guard and give the other side to Stryker, with Griffen of the seniors a strong second. In placing George at guard he is in his natural position, having won his "R" in that position. Stryker has also made good in the same position on this year's "scrub" team.

#### The Tackles.

Gutberlet and Gilmore are placed at tackle. Gutberlet has won his "R" on the varsity "scrubs" and with two years' experience on the second varsity team is the pick for the place. Gilmore is the only man on the team that has been placed from the backfield to the line. Although a splendid line plunger, he is not fast enough for the backfield that has been chosen. His weight and his ability to carry the ball through the line makes him the choice for the other tackle position.

For ends the positions fall to Tollefsen and Mitchie. Both men are fast and both good tacklers. In the two games that they played no material gains were made around either of them, and both showed their ability to handle forward passes. Ankeny of the juniors although a new man at the game played a consistent game and deserves mention.

#### Potter at Quarter.

Tot Potter goes the position of quarterback. His generalship, his speed and his ability to carry the ball give him all the requirements necessary for the position on this team. Coad of the seniors and Phares of the juniors played good heady games and both deserve special mention for the games they played.

The choice of halfbacks are Clancy and Racely. This pair of halfbacks are the best that have been seen on any class team for several years. Racely is fast, is a good ground gainer and above all is a good drop kicker. His drop kick of thirty yards in the senior-freshman game won the game. Clancy showed his ability in plunging
