A notice is to be sent to university organizations calling attention to the list of events which have been scheduled for the next few weeks, and if possible all clubs, societies and other organizations are requested to keep these dates free. A play by the Dramatic club, "Mice and Men," has been scheduled for January 14. Following this charter day with its usual number of exercises including the mid-year

commencement will be had February 15. "University Night," an affair which will be held February 17. The senior play has been scheduled for May 27. This leaves Ivy day as the only event for which the date has not been announced, and there are probably no other university events during the remainder of the school year for which a free date would seem especially desirable.
