HOFFMAN AND HUNTER NEW

TWO IMPORTANT FACULTY ADDITIONS—HOFFMAN, HEAD PROFESSOR OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERING.

Professor Hoffman, late of Purdue University, has taken up his duties as head professor of mechanical engineering and applied mechanics. Professor Hoffman was elected to take the place of Dean Richards, who resigned last spring to accept a position at an increased salary at the University of Illinois.

A Purdue Man.

Professor Hoffman comes to Ne-

braska highly recommended and well fitted for the responsibilities of his important post. He graduated from Purdue University in 1890, receiving his master's degree in engineering three years later.

Since his graduation he has been connected with that institution as instructor and professor.

He is a member of the American Society of Mechanical Engineering, the American Society of Heating and Ventilating Engineering, and the American Association of Refrigerating Engineers. In addition to being an expert on heating and ventilation, Professor Hoffman has a pleasing personality and bids fair to be a popular instructor.

Hunter Is Here.

Fred M. Hunter has taken up his duties as principal of the School of Agriculture, filling the place left vacant by the death of Professor Davison. Mr. Hunter graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1905, and ever since has been a prominent figure in educational circles. That he is a popular addition to the faculty is attested by the cordial reception that is extended to him by university students.

Kiev, Russia.—Dmitry Bogroff, the assassin of Premier Stolypin, was tried by court martial and sentenced to death by hanging. Bogroff shot M.

Stolypin a week ago Thursday night at a gala performance at the opera, and the premier succumbed to the wound Monday night.
