TEN NEBRASKANS TO PUT IN HOLIDAY IN SOCIAL SERVICE WORK.

Ten Nebraska students will spend their holiday in deputation work under the direction of the state committee of Y. M. C. A. Five men will go to Fremont to conduct a campaign and five will visit Fremont in an attempt to help some high school boys solve their difficulties.

The trips will be purely of a social service nature. While all work will center about the religious problem, it will be the aim of the men to scientifically study local conditions and advise with individuals and committees as to the best means of making boy life in the town more enjoyable and raising the life standards of the boys.

The teams will spend five days in the town, the campaign beginning on December 27 and concluding on Sunday, December 31. The Friend team will be composed of Kiddoo, Wiebe, Colbert, Frost, and Beach, and the one going to Fremont will include Arnold, Dinsmore, Plumb, Guidinger, and Rippey.
