NEBRASKA ADOPTS UP-TO-DATE SYSTEM OF INSTRUCTION.

NEBRASKA GRADUATES IN FAVOR

University Authorities Emphasizing the Importance of Practical Study as an Asset.

The University of Nebraska is a real live and growing institution. There is nothing old-fashioned about its methods of instruction and the work of the various departments. These are so well systematized that a student graduating from here has a clear, concise and thorough knowledge of the branch he has taken.

Students finishing from an institution like this are always in demand and are given preference over those who have spent the greater portion of their school life studying subjects which they seldom find occasion to use. That the citizens of the state desire their children to have practical training to fit them for life, and that they consider their state school the proper place for them to receive it is shown by the number of students who are registered for the sciences and professional work.

There are 2,770 students at Nebraska. Three-fourths of them are taking some science; 254 are either specializing in or taking advanced chemistry. The botany department has a proportionally large number, and other scientific courses follow closely.

This does not include the large number of students who are taking professional work, as those registered in the colleges of law, medicine, engineering and pharmacy.

Nebraska as a state and University needs men and women who are intensely practical, who are able to work out the great problems which confront the state and government. The "culture" courses may come later, but now the professional man and woman who are trained are needed, for the place for them to fill is open and the demand exceeds the supply.
