ILLUSTRATED LECTURE.

Miss Cock Gives Picture Story of
Travels, Explorations and Ruins
on Mediterranean.

A large assembly was in attendance at the first convocation of the new semester to listen to the illustrated lecture of Miss Marian Cock on the subject of the explorations in Crete. Miss Cock with a large crowd of tourists chartered a steamer and spent considerable time cruising in the Mediterranean. The party spent most of the time viewing the recent excavations which have revealed ruins of buildings and palaces dating back to about 2,000 B. C.

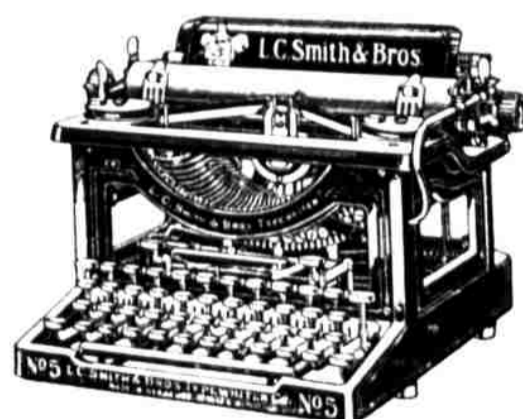
