WORTHLEY A NEBRASKA MAN-CHOSEN AS STUDENT PASTOR

New Methodist Man Granted A. M. Degree Here Last Spring—Graduate of Wesleyan Also.

Mr. E. A. Worthley, who was appointed by the recent convention of Nebraska Methodists to take the position of University pastor, is not entering into a strange field of operations. For he is a Nebraska man, familiar with the ways of this campus. He was granted his master's degree last spring by Nebraska University, having spent the year as a fellow in the department of sociology.

In the spring of 1908 Rev. Worthley was graduated from Wesleyan. Be-

tween that time and this he has been engaged in regular ministerial as well as Y. M. C. A. work, being especially interested in the sociological problems with which he came in contact. He is a young man, and his appointment by the conference marks him as a man who enjoys the confidence of his colleagues in the work. He will work in co-operation with Drs. Leland and Howard, the other student pastors.
