**LINCOLN HIGH WILL MEET
BEATRICE HERE TOMORROW**

For First Athletic Encounter in Past Three Years.—Will Take Place on Nebraska Field.

Lincoln High and Beatrice will meet on the University Athletic field Saturday in the first athletic encounter the two schools have engaged in for three years.

Both teams are in prime condition and appear to be evenly matched, both in weight and knowledge of the game; and both have about the same record to their credit in regard to their record for this year. Aurora downed Beatrice and Lincoln, in each case having a margin of seven points.

Former scores show Lincoln to have had the strongest teams.
