Organization Committee Rules.

The attention of students of the University is called to the following rules, adopted by the Committee on Student Organizations, June 6, 1912, and published in The Daily Nebraskan, October 18, 1912.

Auditor of Student Organizations.

Special rules Governing parties, banquets, entertainments, etc.

The organization (or its properly accredited officers) shall appoint a business manager (or chairman of committee) to take charge of each entertainment given in the name of the organization.

The business manager shall be personally responsible for all tickets issued and all money received. Tickets to any such entertainment shall be valid only when validated by the auditor of student organizations, and the business manager shall submit to the auditor not later than noon of the Monday following such entertainment an accounting of the entertainment, including a statement of all bills incurred, all unsold tickets and a receipt from the treasurer of the organization for the value of all tickets sold or unaccounted for.

All complimentary tickets are non-transferable and shall be endorsed by the business manager with the name of the person to whom they are issued, before they are validated by the auditor.

The business manager shall hire a door-keeper accredited by the auditor of student organizations who shall take all tickets at the door and deliver them to the auditor.

Not later than noon of Friday of the week following such entertainment the treasurer shall submit to the auditor receipts showing payment of all bills incurred so far as funds of the organization are available.
