students, or the University as a whole, is played up and magnified, often-times to such an extent that by the time it reaches the people out in the state they are led to believe that the University is a place largely taken up with questionable things and methods on the part of the students.

Many suggestions have been made as to how to remedy this false impression. Extension of University activities is at once the most plausible. The appearance of the various organizations over the state would give the people an opportunity to see for themselves the amount of talent the students have, and in a greater degree what the University is doing in the way of training, to bring out the better parts of every student. Not every talented student is engaged in one of the more important activities, but as a general thing the majority of the students are represented in some one or other.

The University of Minnesota is one of the most popular with the people of the state of any University in the country. Time was when their methods were looked upon with suspicion by the taxpayers and the people upon whose support it depended were loath to expend much money on the institution. This has all changed. Today they have one of the best faculties in the entire country, their registration compares with that of any school in the West and their campus is second to none in the country. University extension may not have been the only thing which contributed to this state of affairs, but freeing the people's mind from prejudice brought about larger appropriations from the state legislature and in this way the school expended large amounts of money for its betterment.

If extension can be brought about at Nebraska the real value of what the University stands for and what it is doing for its students will be made plain. People of the state will boost for Nebraska at every opportunity. When questionable articles or attacks are circulated throughout the state they will be immediately tabooed by the people and there will no longer be a field for such. The people will demand that their University be given an equal chance with that of all other Western universities and the result will be that we will get larger appropriations from the legislature and become a bigger, better and faster growing institution, to which not only the good citizens of our own state will be proud to send their sons and daughters, but people of neighboring states as well will hear of our greatness and Nebraska will be a mecca for those persons who desire a good modern education. **RUSSELL SWIFT.**
